



Elias Ishoel Wins Pro Snocross Opener In Minnesota



Winnipeg, MB (November 26, 2018) - A fully-healthy Elias Ishoel chased down early race leader Lincoln Lemieux to win round one of the AMSOIL Championship Snocross series, putting the BOSS Racing Jimmy John's team on top of the Pro podium once again. "It feels so good, I'm so glad to be back healthy," said Ishoel during a post-race interview on the CBS Sports Network. It's so fun to be on the Jimmy John's sled, it works so good and I can't wait to keep moving on from here for a strong season."

The win was just one of many highlights during the weekend as rookie Pro Aki Pihlaja has a great debut in the premier class finishing fifth in his first-ever main event. Pihlaja qualified for the final again on Sunday, while Ishoel backed up his performance on day two, with another podium finish in third place finish. As a result, Ishoel left Duluth, Minnesota with the red number plate identifying him as the high point rider in the series championship. Pihlaja, by way of strong qualifying heat race finishes, is not far behind in the seventh position.



The team's Ski-Doo race sleds were strong right out of the box as both riders qualified for the 16 man head-to-head Dominator race on Friday, where they ultimately squared off against each other in the semi-finals. Pihlaja would get the edge in that race and advance to the three man main event.

The team will be hard at work in the shop this week before hitting the road for rounds three and four in Jackson Hole, Wyoming on December 7-8.
