



Elias Ishoel Wins Again, Expanding Championship Lead In Jackson Hole



Elias Ishoel picked up his second win of the season at round four of the ISOC national snoross tour and left Jackson Hole, Wyoming with a 25 point lead in the Pro championship as the tour begins a three week break for the holidays.

Ishoel was nearly perfect in qualifying winning three out of four heat races and finishing second in the other. On Friday he was pushed wide on the start of the main event, had to maneuver around the first obstacle, and raced forward from nearly last in the fifteen man field to finish fourth.

Teammate Aki Pihlaja finished just behind Ishoel on Friday in fifth place. On Saturday, Pihlaja raced side-by-side with Ishoel off of the starting line and over the first jump for a picture perfect start for the Jimmy John's team. Aki was in contention for another quality finish in only his fourth race in the premier class when he tangled with another rider, damaging his front ski spindle and having to drop out of the race.



The team is firing on all cylinders and looking forward to making even more gains over the break, before the series resumes at the critical rounds five and six at Canterbury Park in Minneapolis, Minnesota on January 4-5.
