



Elias Ishoel Wins at ERX Motor Park



Defending ISOC Pro Champion Elias Ishoel recovered from a crash in the first corner of Friday night's main event to storm back for a win at round two on Saturday in Elk River, Minnesota.

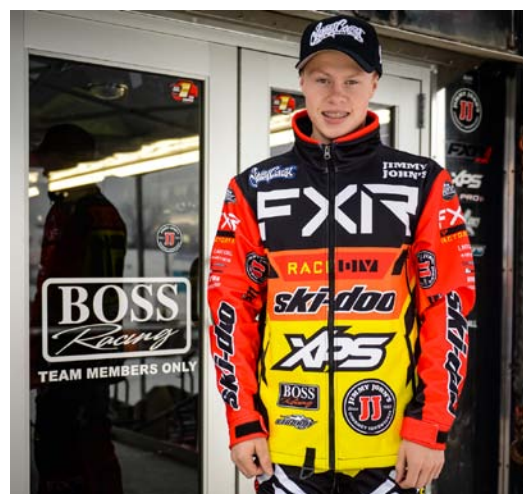
Despite a 14th place finish in the opening round, Ishoel's strong qualifying performances throughout the weekend, contributed to a point total that has him second in the Pro class standing as the series moves on to rounds three and four this weekend,

The course at ERX Motor Park featured plenty of snow but temperatures that hovered just under the freezing point made for heavy fog and snow dust that greatly limited passing opportunities. Fortunately, Elias was one of the few riders who took advantage of every gap, including a highlight reel ride from fourth to first on Saturday night.

Elias Ishoel -

"Yesterday I crashed in the first corner," said Ishoel on the podium. "I just started over today and tried to find the good lines. They were really difficult to find and pass out there, and after yesterday, it's just been good today."

Unfortunately, the team did suffer an emotional setback on Saturday when rookie Pro Lite racer Jordan Lebel was injured at the start of his main event. Lebel was involved in a crash and then struck by another rider while stepping away



from his snowmobile. He sustained four fractured vertebrae and a laceration to his spleen and kidney. The fractures were to the "wings" on his vertebrae and did not cause any trauma to his spine. In fact he was up walking the next day and is being treated at Children's Hospital in Minneapolis.
