



## Elias Ishoel Enters Rare Air With Third Straight Pro Snocross Championship



Elias Ishoel entered the final weekend of national snocross competition with a commanding lead in the Pro championship. That did not stop the two-time defending champ from finishing the season on full blast, as the young Norwegian star guided his XPS Ski-Doo to a sweep of the main events on Friday and Saturday night to tally wins number 10 and 11 of the 16 race campaign.

Ishoel was able to wrap up the title by virtue of his win on Friday.

"I got a really good holeshoot, and then I got the pass and then the lead," said Ishoel. "I just had to stay smooth and stay smart, at least smarter than last weekend. No better way to win the championship than to win tonight."

Ishoel's on-the-edge riding style, supported by a team of mechanics who provided him with a machine that finished every single lap of competition during the season, resulted in a third straight championship.

Elias is one of only three riders in the history of the sport to accomplish this feat and the only currently active racer to do so.

At the conclusion of the weekend, BOSS Racing crew member Jessy Cournoyer was named the series' Mechanic of the Year.
